- **30 MPH Speed Limit fixed sign** – request declined due to this being prohibited within Road Traffic legislation, suggestion to have this painted on the road.
- **Pot Holes Stamford Rd/Green Man Lane** – road repairs have been carried out.
- **Reactive Speed Signs** – this would be subject to a Lottery grant application, 12 weeks for a decision to be made.
