Next Parish Council Meeting:

Parish Council Elections:

Elections for Marholm Parish Council will take place on 5th May 2022. All five parish councillor positions are up for election.

Parish Councillor duties:

- Attend meetings – once every two months
- Raise residents' concerns and look for solutions
- Be the voice of the residents with PCC e.g., fly-tipping
- Identify potential village projects e.g., planting, gateways, benches etc.
- Ensure repairs are carried e.g., bridge, drains, streetlights, road signs etc.

We are looking for at least two new parish councillors. Nominations need to be in by 4pm on 5th April 2022.

What level of nominations does the Parish Council need?

- at least 3 nominations to continue
- 5 nominations to fill all the positions
- more than 5 nominations, an election will need to be held
